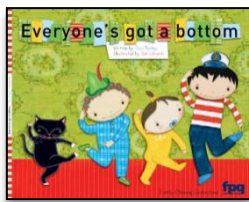

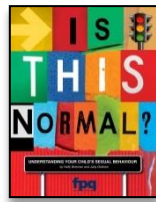


A colourful storybook for children aged 3-8, it is a tool for parents and carers to

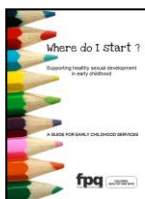


This resource is designed to promote personal safety skills in a fun and accessible way for children aged between 5-10 years.
