How to use this poster

This poster has been designed to be used by schools and early childhood education centres that want their learning place to be a safe and inclusive environment for children, young people, staff and their families who identify as gender diverse and/or LGBTIQ+.

This poster can be used in numerous ways:

- By schools or early education centres to actively promote themselves in their community as an inclusive organisation to their community;
- by an individual employed by a school or early education centre to identify themselves as a key contact that can provide support and
- information; or to designate a safe space within the organisation. Inclusive learning spaces maximise the wellbeing of children and young people.
